And the mind goes to the rich man when Jesus ask him to give everything that he has and follow Jesus we can find it at the Gospel of Mark 10:17-23. On that passage we can see what the treasure of that man was. Also you might remember Peter in Acts 3:6-7. Silver or gold i do not have, but what i have I give to you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk.

You can see that both men were asked to give what they have. Both acted based on what their treasure was... The man on the Gospel of Mark was very rich physically but very poor spiritually. Peter was not rich physically but was rich spiritually and what he have he shared with others. And Peter through the power of Jesus Christ made that crippled man him to walk. Now we do not have the power make people to walk physically, but we know for sure that we have the power to make them walk spiritually.

Or you might remember the parable of Talents that Jesus told in Matthew 25:14-30, for those that use the talent that they had invested, God blessed them more and for the one that did not use it but hid it on the ground. Now imagine the Treasure or the Talent or whatever we can named the one that God has given to us, and we decide not to share with others, or we may decide that is enough I am tired that's all I can't do any more!!

Well we never never have to decide not to share it (THE GOOD NEWS) and never and never decide to stop doing on what we are doing.

Thinking how many give birth every day. Also how many die every day that do not know about Christ.!!??

The bank when gives you money it gives with interest and you pay the interest till the dead line that you have decided to pay all the money. The Salvation of God is with interest also to and the Interest to share with the others about the Salvation that you received till the end of your life, and the same time God will bless you during the time on the earth, and he will continue to bless after

you leave the earth for the eternity with Him.

The Activity of the Week

Actually the first part of the week it has been quite and not to much to say,

We studied Romans chapter 7 and Edi taught the class and He challenged us How to find pleasure in the Law of God?, we were about 10 people during the Bible class. You will find an outline of the Bible class on the page of Bible Class.
